#### SAMPLE ITINERARY

#### DAY 1 – Perth

Arrive in Perth and settle into your centrally located hotel before meeting your Tour Director and fellow travellers. This afternoon, enjoy a city highlights tour including a visit to Kings Park, a peaceful inner-city escape with sweeping views over Perth and a vibrant display of native wildflowers. This evening, enjoy a special welcome dinner at Reel Kitchen, overlooking the beautiful Swan River. **D**

Stay: 1 night at DoubleTree by Hilton Perth Waterfront

#### DAY 2 – Perth – Margaret River

Leaving the city behind, journey south to the picturesque Margaret River Region, famed for its world-class wines, pristine coastline, tall timber forests, and ancient caves; a perfect base for the next two nights. Lunch at Leeuwin Estate is a delight, where fine wines, delicious food, art, and music come together. A visit to the towering Karri Forest of Boranup, home to trees over 60 metres tall, is sure to impress. Immerse yourself in the sights, sounds, and scents of this natural wonder, surrounded by wildflowers, ferns, and native birdlife. Tonight, enjoy dinner at the Margaret River Brewhouse. **B.L.D**

Stay: 2 nights at Margarets in Town

#### DAY 3 – Margaret River

Spend the morning exploring Margaret River township before visiting Gabriel Chocolate, Western Australia's first bean-to-bar maker, to sample their creations and learn about the process. Next, take a self-guided tour of Mammoth Cave to see ancient fossils and a 50,000-year-old "zygomaturus" jawbone. Later, visit Yallingup for stunning coastal views and a stroll along the beach. Tonight, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. **B.L.D**

#### DAY 4 – Margaret River - Busselton - Fremantle - Rottnest Island

Today, we travel to Busselton to walk its famous 1.7-kilometre jetty that stretches into the turquoise waters of Geographe Bay. We then continue north through the coastal towns of Bunbury and Mandurah, stopping for lunch at the beach. In the afternoon, arrive in Fremantle and board the Rottnest Express ferry to Rottnest Island / Wadjemup. Explore the island's history, wildlife, and scenic beauty, including 10,000 quokkas, during your 2-night stay. **B.L.D**

Stay: 2 nights at The Lodge Wadjemup

#### DAY 5 – Rottnest Island

Enjoy your morning at leisure and explore Rottnest Island at your own pace. Later, join a guided bus tour of the island's scenic highlights, learning about its unique history, diverse wildlife and significant cultural sites. You'll have time to unwind in the afternoon – perhaps with a swim, a coastal walk, or more quokka spotting. This evening, share stories over a final dinner together at the hotel. **B.L.D**

#### DAY 6 – Farewell

Following breakfast, board the Rottnest Express back to Fremantle. Upon arrival, rejoin the Outback Spirit coach for your transfer to Perth Airport. **B**
